# **Acknowledged Statements**

- Purpose: Person declares (acknowledges) signing a document voluntarily for the purposes and considerations stated in it.
- Signer acknowledges that he/she signed the document voluntarily, for its stated purpose.
- Requires an Acknowledgment.
  - "Do you acknowledge that you are the person named in the documents and you are signing the documents willingly for its stated purpose?"
- Acknowledgment Language: "Acknowledged before me by John Doe this XX day of [Month] [Year]..."
- Used in documents in which the signer is agreeing to the terms in the documents.
  - Deeds, Powers of Attorney

### Requirements

- Notary Public must be located within the State of Texas.
- All signing parties can be located anywhere in the world and must be able to meet personal information and device requirements

### **Sworn Statements (Jurats)**

- Purpose: To compel truthfulness under penalties of perjury about a statement or promise.
- Signer is swearing to the truthfulness of the document's contents.
- Requires an Oath or Affirmation.
  - Verbal Oath: "Do you, John Doe, affirm under penalties of perjury, that the contents of this document are true, so help you God?"
  - Verbal Authorization: "Do you, John Doe, affirm under penalties of perjury that the contents of this document are true?"
- Jurat Language: "Subscribed and sworn to before me by John Doe this XX day of [Month] [Year]..."
- Used in documents in which the signer supplied certain information.
   Grantor's Affidavit, Residential Grantor's Affidavit

## Requirements

- Notary Public must be located within the State of Texas.
- All signing parties can be located anywhere in the world and must be able to meet personal information and device requirements.
